Uniform Information

With warmer temperatures finally arriving, please be sure to follow the uniform guidelines in the NWCS Family/Student Handbook.

As a reminder, navy blue twill, uniform-style shorts may be worn by all students. Shorts may be no shorter than four inches above the knee. Shorts must be fastened securely at the waist. If shorts cannot be worn securely at the waist, a belt must be worn. Cargo shorts are not permitted. *7th and 8th grade students have the option of wearing khaki twill, uniform-style shorts, skirts, or skorts.*

All jumpers, skirts, and skorts must be of the appropriate size and be worn at the waist. They must be no shorter than four inches above the knee. *7th and 8th grade girls have the option of wearing khaki twill, uniform-style skirts and skorts.*

Socks or tights are required at all times and must be solid navy blue, red, black, or white.
